‘Back to the Shack’, a group exhibition curated by expressionist German painter André Butzer is being jointly presented by Friedens-Siemense Co. and Meliksetian | Briggs, Los Angeles.

André Butzer has invited artists from all over the United States and Europe to present their works in this show. The show is a following-up event to an earlier exhibition in February 2017 in New York, “Lob des Schattens - DJ Piet Mondrian´s Sister in the Year 2849- and her books (from Vienna)”, a project Butzer helped to organize alongside NY-artist [John Newsom](#).

André Butzer's work is a combination of abstraction and figuration inspired by art history, comics, politics, and animation with a dash of humour. He has created his own style of work that he terms as “science-fiction Expressionism.” Butzer was born in Stuttgart, now based in Rangsdorf, Germany.
